This series are state-of-the-art devices designed for use in switching power supplies, inverters and as free wheeling diodes.

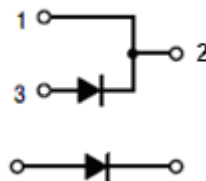
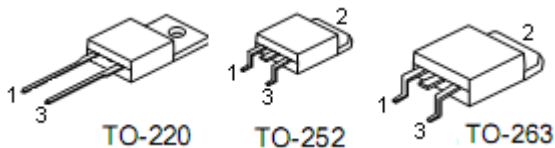
## 2. Features

- n Ultrafast 25 nanosecond recovery time
- n 175°C operating junction temperature
- n Epoxy meets UL 94 V-0 @ 0.125 in
- n Low forward voltage
- n Low leakage current
- n High temperature glass passivated junction
- n Reverse voltage to 700 V
- n Pb-free packages are available

## 3. Mechanical Characteristics

- n Case: epoxy, molded
- n Weight: 1.9 grams (approximately)
- n Finish: all external surfaces corrosion resistant and terminal
- n Leads are readily solderable
- n Lead temperature for soldering purposes: 260°C max for 10 seconds
