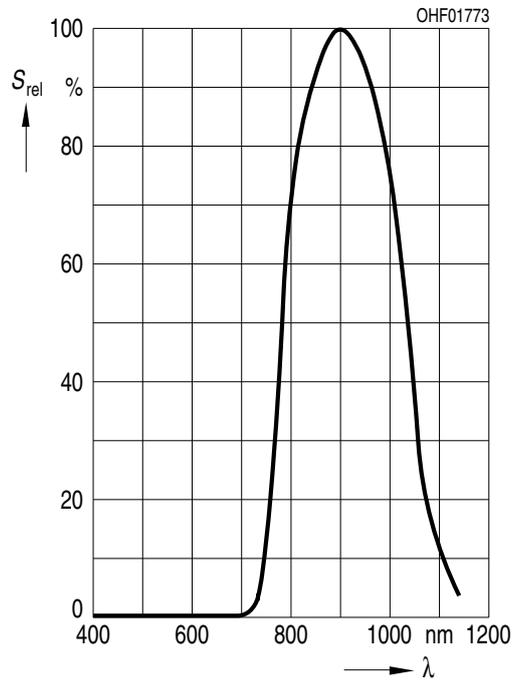

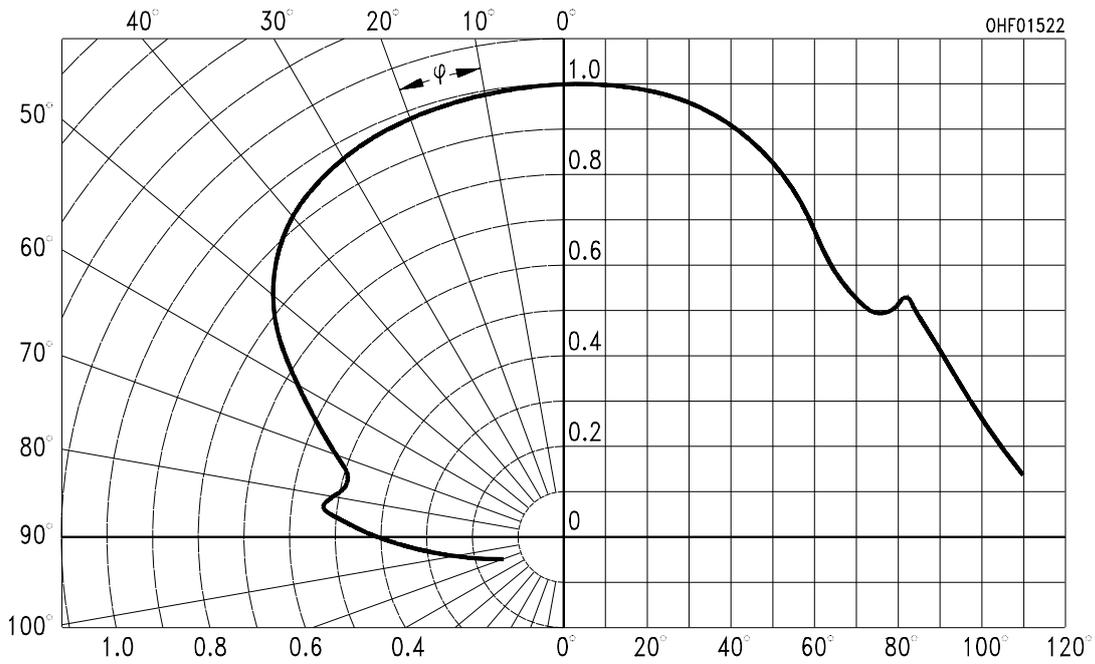

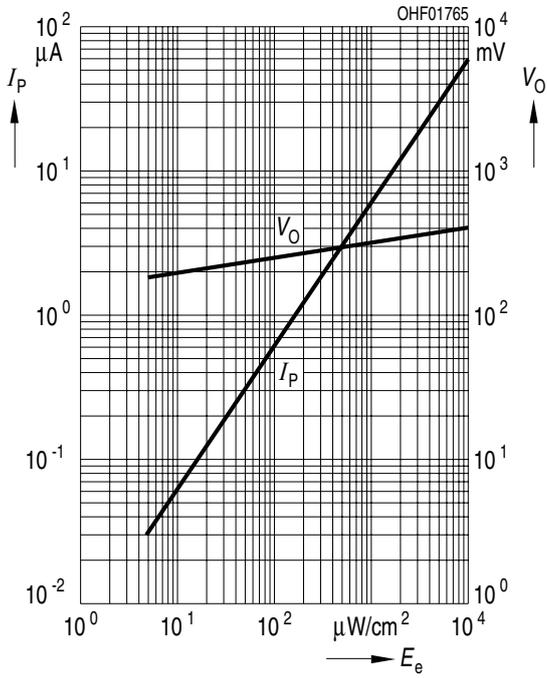
Directional Characteristics ^{1), 2)}

$$S_{rel} = f(\varphi)$$



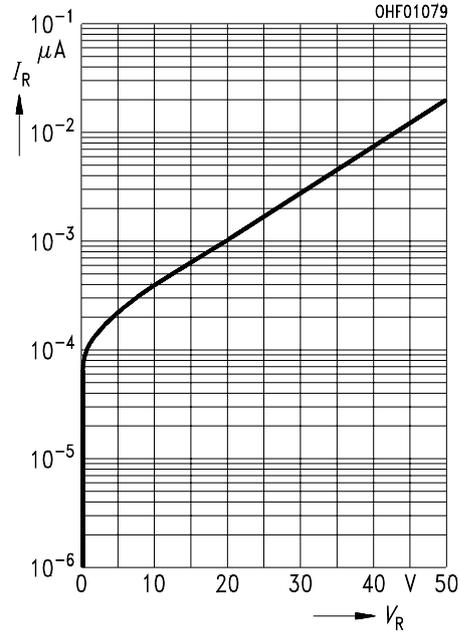
Photocurrent/Open-Circuit Voltage ^{1), 2)}

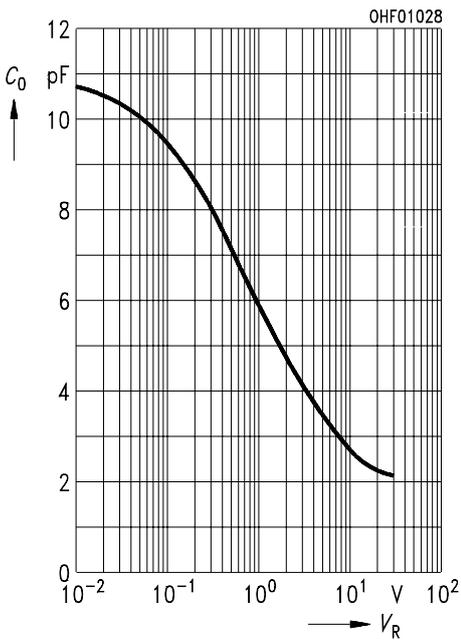

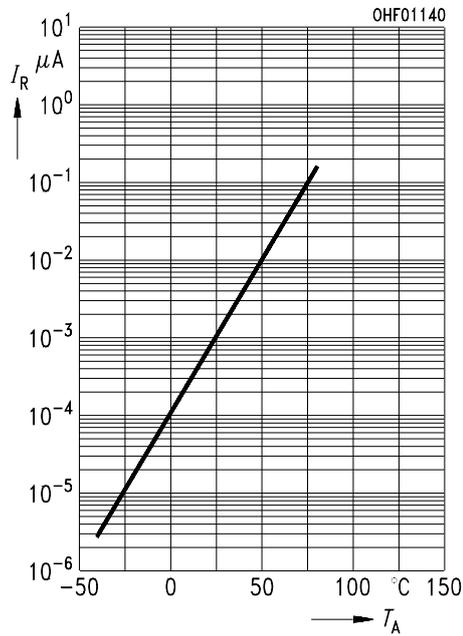

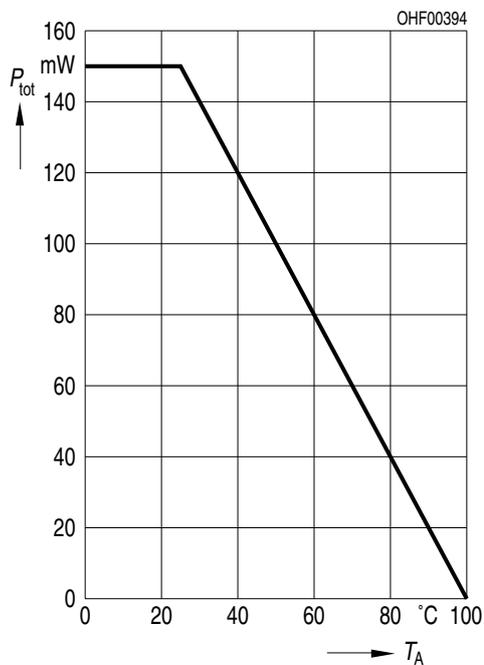
Dark Current ²⁾

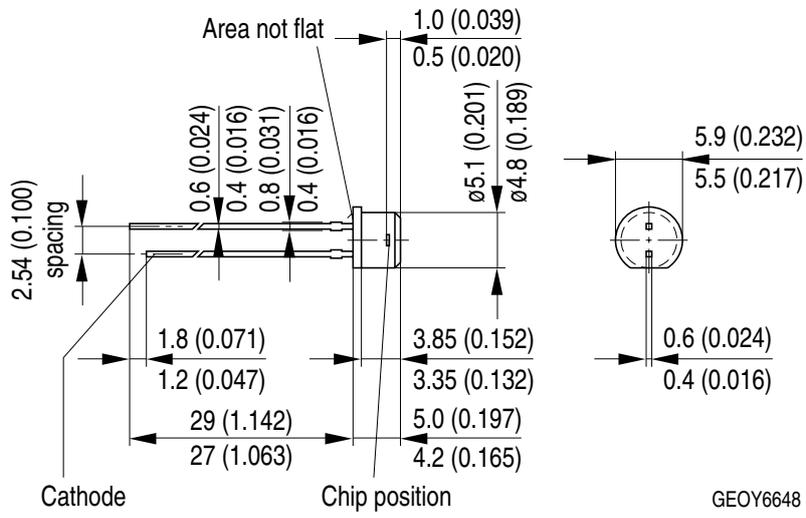


Power Consumption

$$P_{\text{tot}} = f(T_A);$$



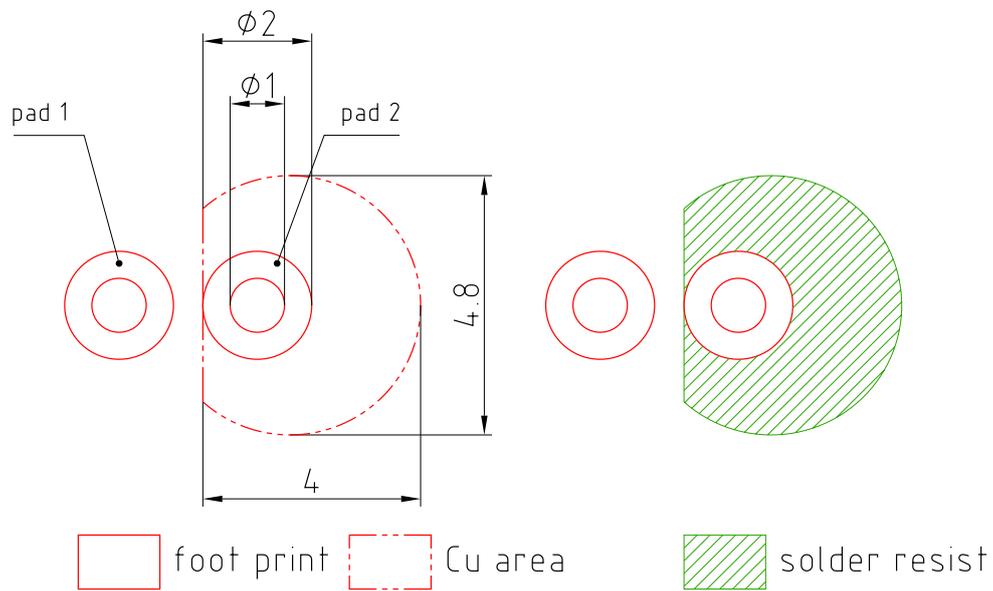
Dimensional Drawing ³⁾

Recommended Solder Pad ³⁾

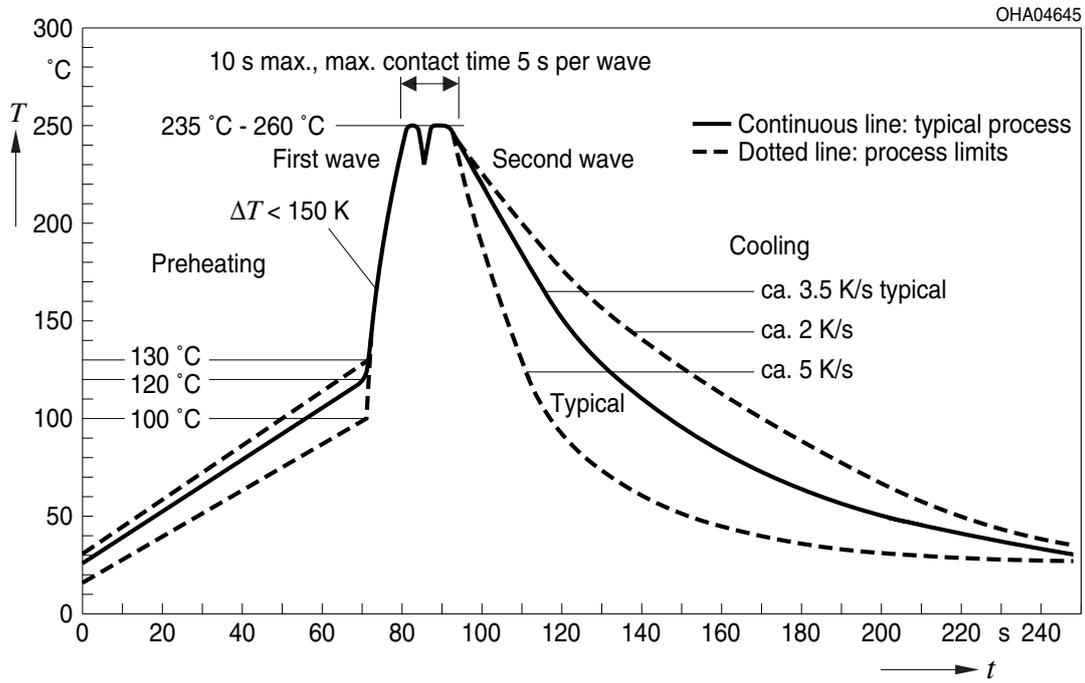

Notes
