


Figure 1. Typ. output characteristics




Figure 3. Typ. capacitances




Figure 5. Drain-source breakdown voltage




Figure 2. Typ. transfer characteristics




Figure 4. Typ. gate charge




Figure 6. Drain-source on-state resistance






Figure 7. Forward characteristic of body diode




Figure 9. Safe operation area T<sub>C</sub>=25 ℃







Figure 8. Drain current


