### **Description**

The NC7S04 is a single high performance CMOS Inverter. Advanced Silicon Gate CMOS fabrication assures high speed and low power circuit operation over a broad  $V_{CC}$  range. 



Figure 1. Logic Symbol




Figure 2. SOT23-5, SC-88A and SC-74A (Top View)




Figure 3. MicroPak (Top Through View)



Figure 4. AC Test Circuit





Figure 6. AC Waveforms


