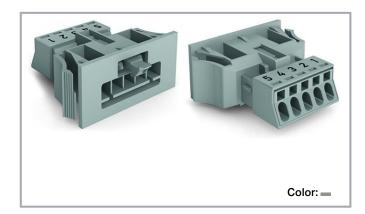
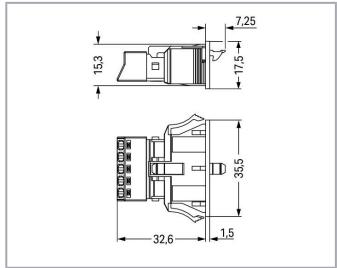
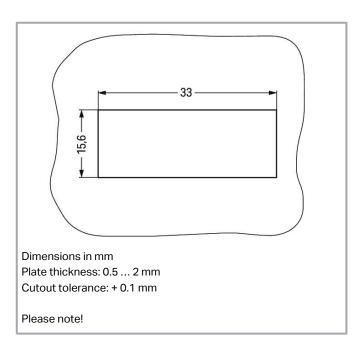

The wings of the snap-in connectors must not be mechanically stressed for a long period before use (e.g., due to a pre-locking position).

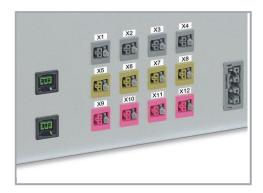
