


V<sub>GS</sub> - Gate-to-Source Voltage (V) On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage






Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient






Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient





T<sub>C</sub> - Case Temperature (°C) **Current Derating\*** 









Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient




Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Foot


