

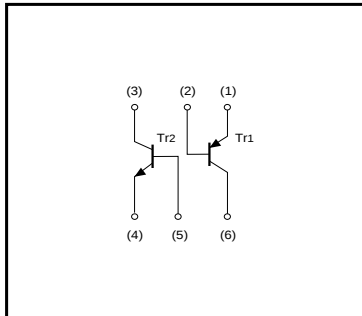

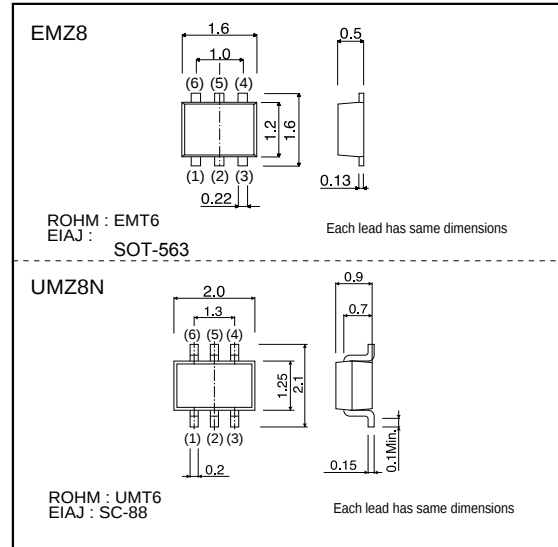

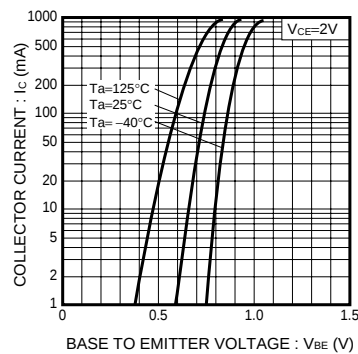


Fig.1 Grounded Emitter Propagation Characteristics

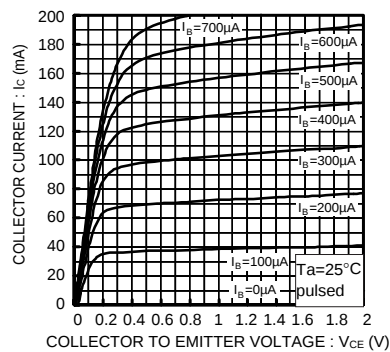


Fig.2 Typical Output Characteristics

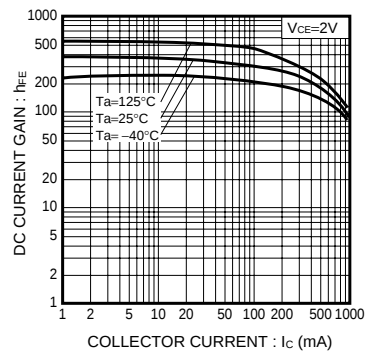


Fig.3 DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

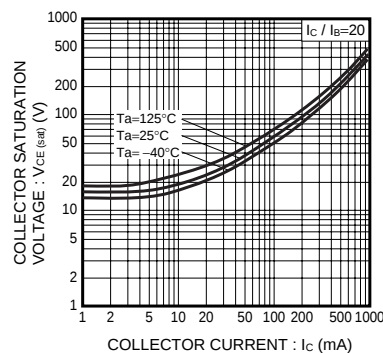


Fig.4 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current (I)

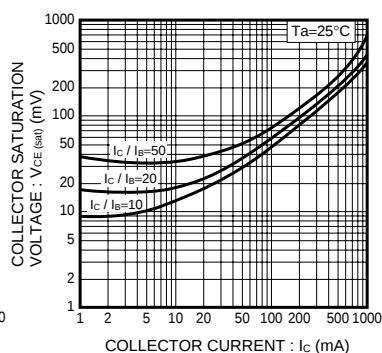


Fig.5 Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current (II)

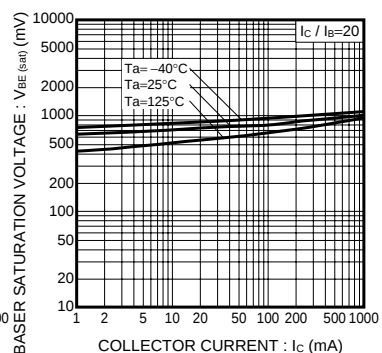


Fig.6 Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current

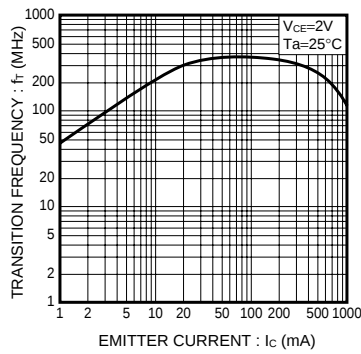
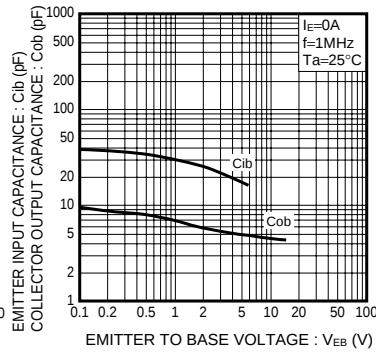


Fig.7 Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Emitter Current

Emitter Input Capacitance vs. Emitter-Base Voltage

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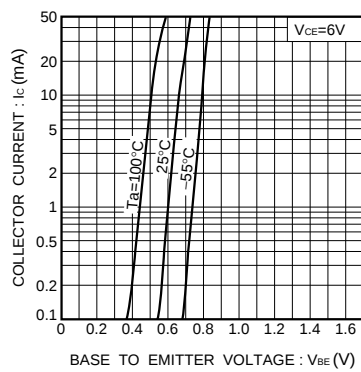


Fig.1 Grounded emitter propagation characteristics

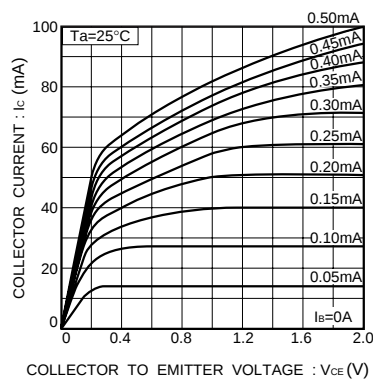


Fig.2 Grounded emitter output characteristics (I)

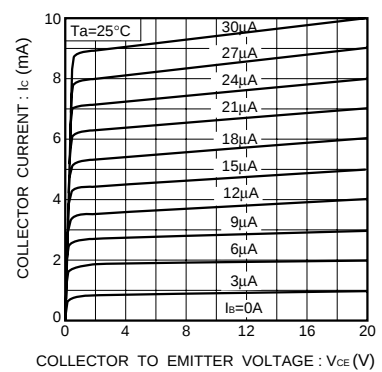


Fig.3 Grounded emitter output characteristics (II)

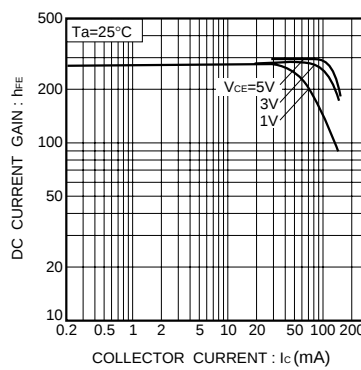


Fig.4 DC current gain vs. collector current (I)

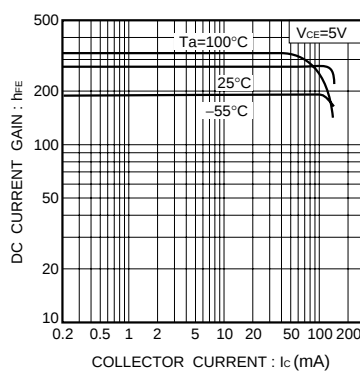


Fig.5 DC current gain vs. collector current (II)

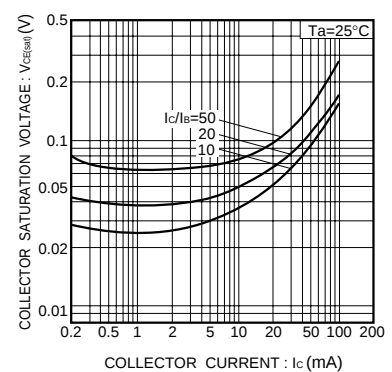


Fig.6 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current

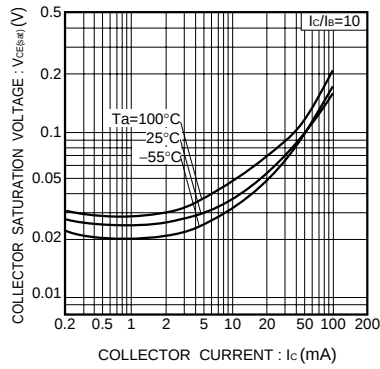


Fig. 7 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current (I)

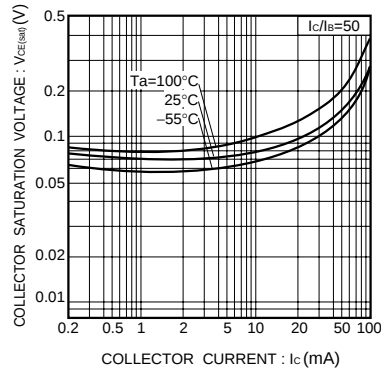


Fig. 8 Collector-emitter saturation voltage vs. collector current (II)

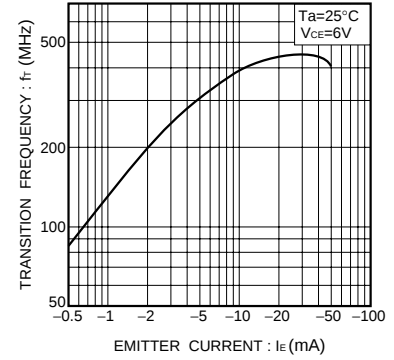


Fig. 9 Gain bandwidth product vs. emitter current

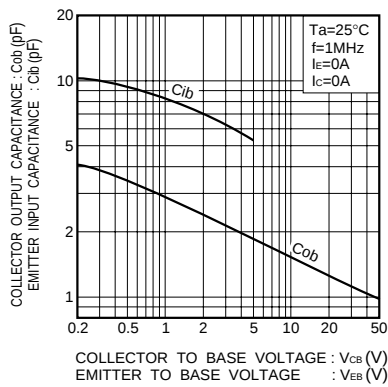


Fig. 10 Collector output capacitance vs. collector-base voltage
Emitter input capacitance vs. emitter-base voltage

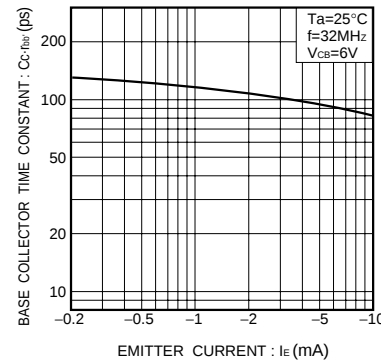


Fig. 11 Base-collector time constant vs. emitter current

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
