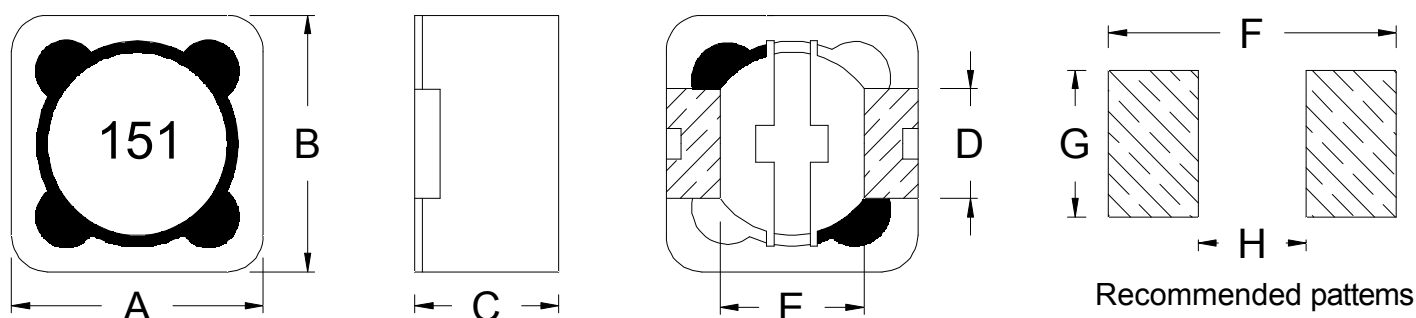


## 1. External Dimensions (Unit:m/m)

### Notes:

- 1) All test data is referenced to 25°C ambient.
- 2) Operating temperature range -40°C to +105°C, (Including self - temperature rise).
- 3) Isat :DC current(A) that will cause  $I_o$  to drop approximately 35%.
- 4) The part temperature(ambient + temp rise)should not exceed 105°C under worst case operating conditions. Circuit design,component placement, PCB trace size and thickness,airflow and other cooling provisions all affect the part temperature,part temperature should be verified in the end application.
