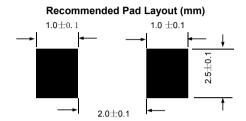

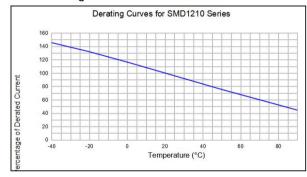

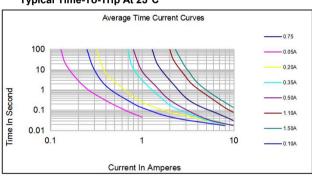

#### **Thermal Derating Curve**

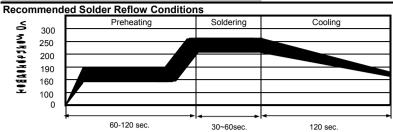


#### Typical Time-To-Trip At 25°C



# NARNING:

- · Contamination of the PPTC material with certain silicon based oils or some aggressive solvents can adversely impact the performance of the devices. PPTC SMD can be cleaned by standard methods.
- · Requests that customers comply with our recommended solder pad layouts and recommended reflow profile. Improper board layouts or reflow profile could negatively impact solderability performance of our devices.



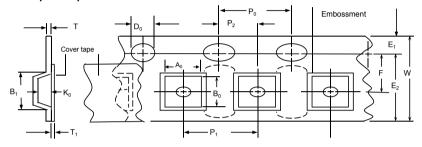
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Recommended reflow methods : IR, vapor phase oven, hot air oven.
- Devices are not designed to be wave soldered to the bottom side of the board.
- Recommended maximum paste thickness is 0.25 mm (0.010 inch).
- Devices can be cleaned using standard method and solvents.

Note: If reflow temperatures exceed the recommended profile, devices may not meet the performance requirements.

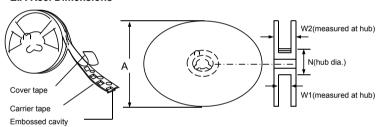

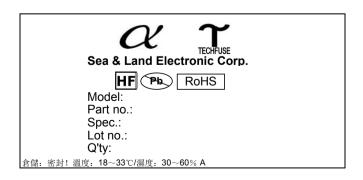
