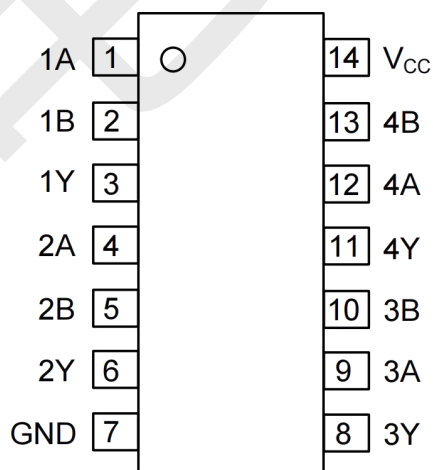
General Description

Functional diagram

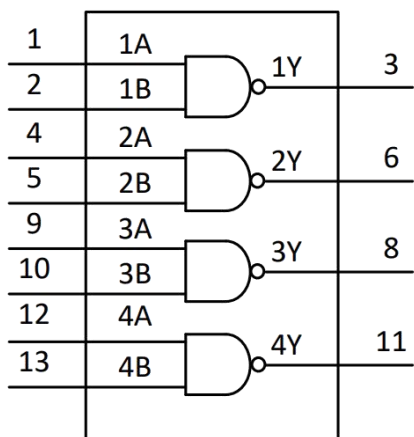


Fig. 1. Logic symbol

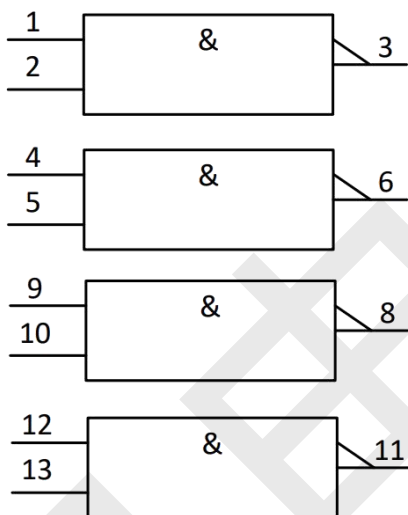


Fig. 2. IEC logic symbol

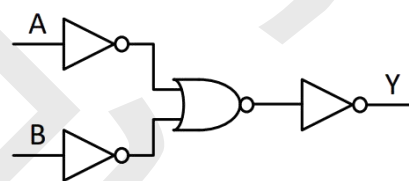


Fig. 3. Logic diagram(one gate)

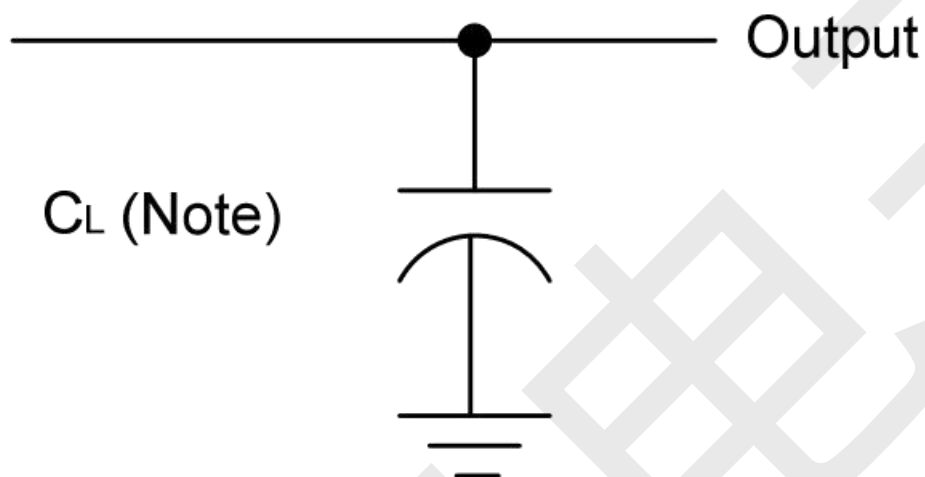

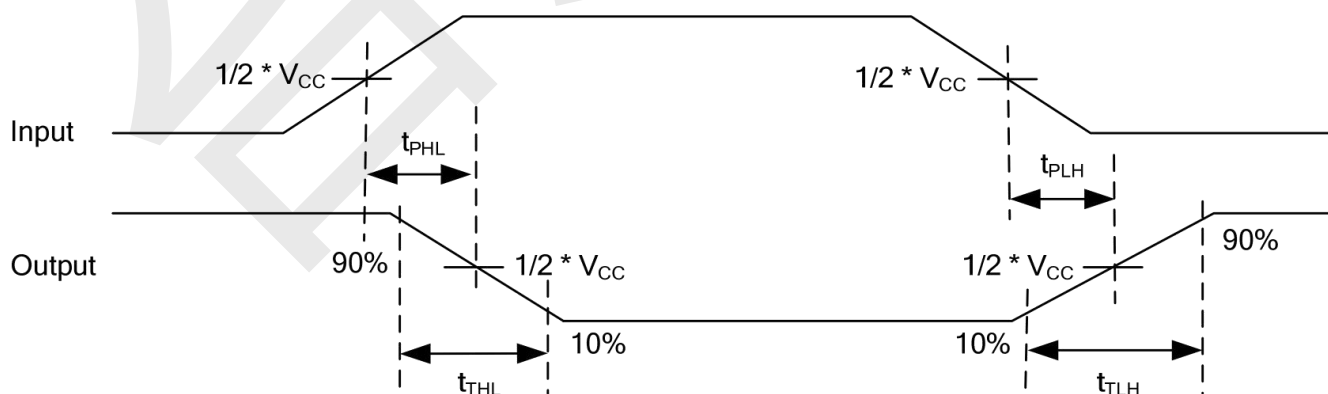

Testing Circuit

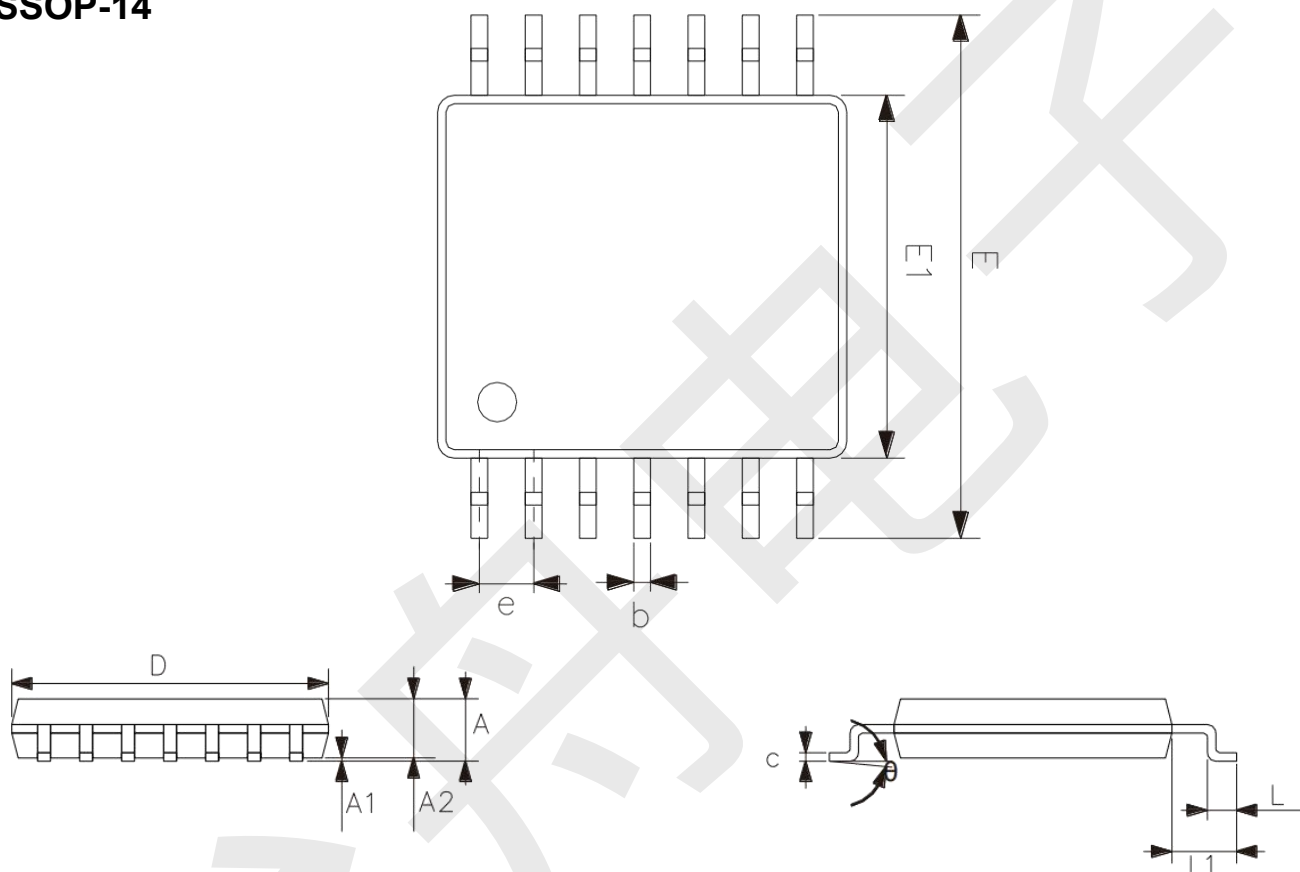


Note: C_L includes probe and jig capacitance.
